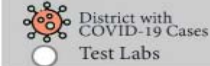

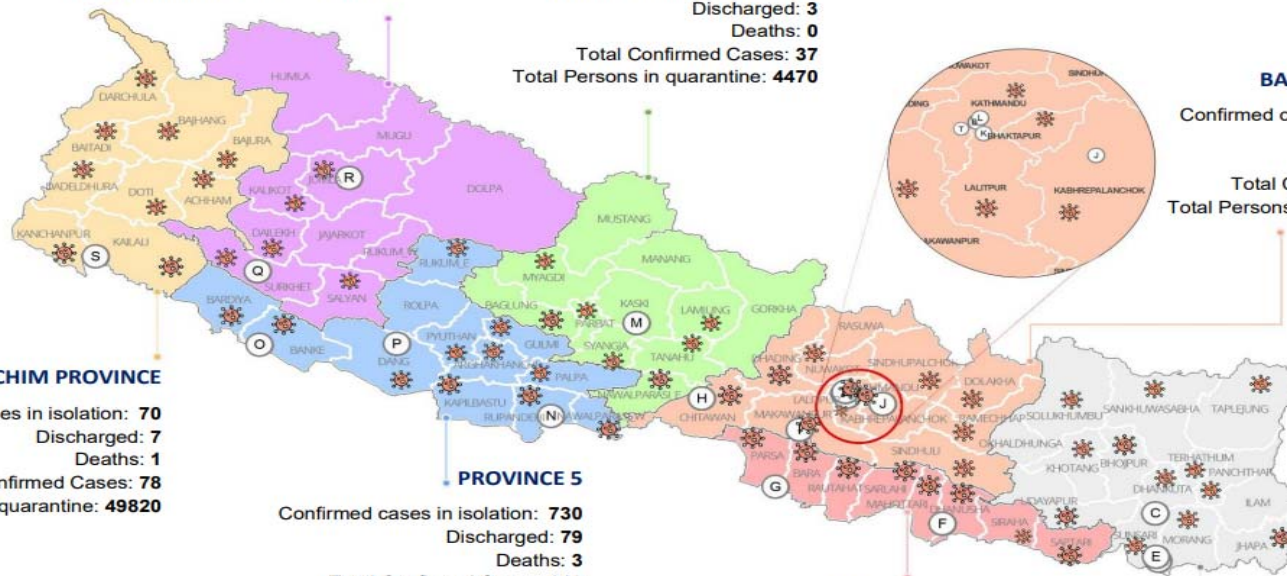

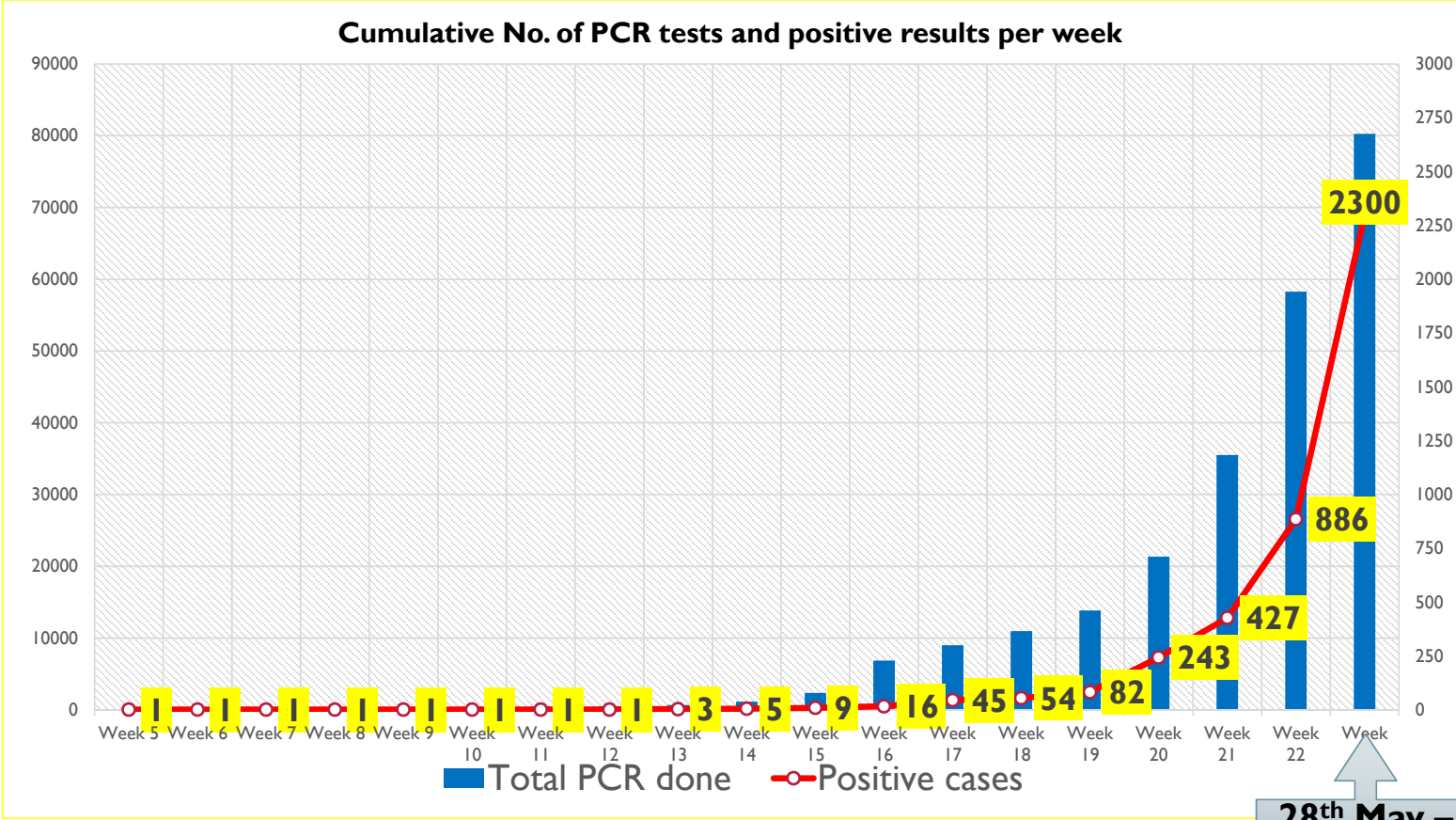

### THIS WEEK

- GIZ provided 4000 Sanitary pack needs for female health workers in 4 Corona Hub Hospitals (Sukraraj Tropical Disease Hospital, Bir Hospital, Patan Hospital and Nepal Armed Police Force Hospital)
  - Save the Children: 800 mosquito nets were handed over to Province 5 for quarantine places,
  - United Distributors Nepal Pvt. Ltd (VG Foundation, VGL Co. CSRARM) handed over Gloves, KN-95 Masks, Thermometer, Protection suit
  - Good Neighbors International provided 1000 pieces of PPE, 2000 pieces of Surgical mask, 1000 pairs of Sterile gloves, 1200 pieces of KN-95 masks and 1200 pairs of Eye Goggles
  - On the initiative of Buddhist Tzu Chi Foundation, Health Care Foundation Nepal (HECAF) has provided Ministry of Health and Population with 30 ventilators and medical supplies.

## MHPSS PROGRESS & SOME ISSUES

---

- A short term plan: *COVID 19 Intervention Framework on MHPSS* has been endorsed and is being budgeted for the implementation- Interested partners will be approached for funding for specific areas
- MHPSS for person in quarantine setting are provided focused attention in province 2 and 5 nd similar initiatives are planned in other provinces
- MHPSS organization are active at provincial level and focal organizations identified in all provinces except for Baghmata, which will soon be identified and they will be part of the provincial health cluster
- Some of the challenges are: Travel pass for MH support staff to travel to provinces during lock down and difficulty in admission of homeless people in mental health residential care or treatment homes without testing for COVID-19

- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) (N95, full set)
- Logistics for labs especially - Testing kits, RTPCR reagents
- Support to Hub hospitals for the expansion of Isolation wards
- Help in improving health conditions in quarantine
- Help health facilities for the continuation of services
