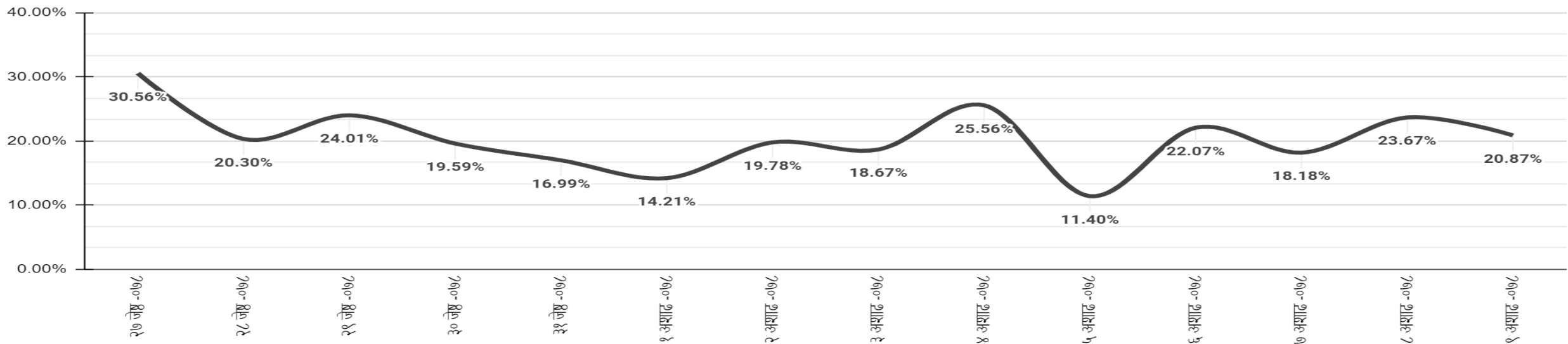

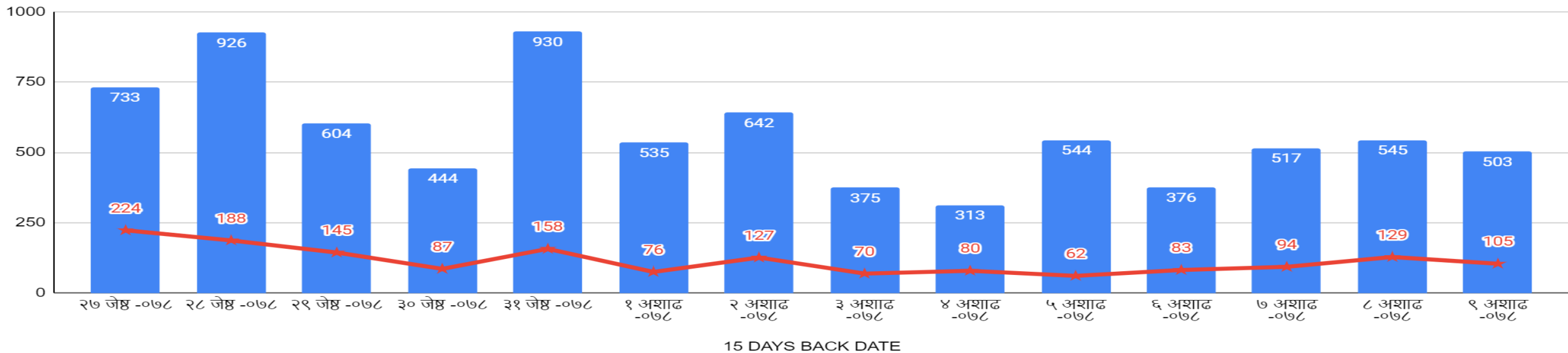

TEST VS POSITIVE CASES TREND (RT-PCR only)

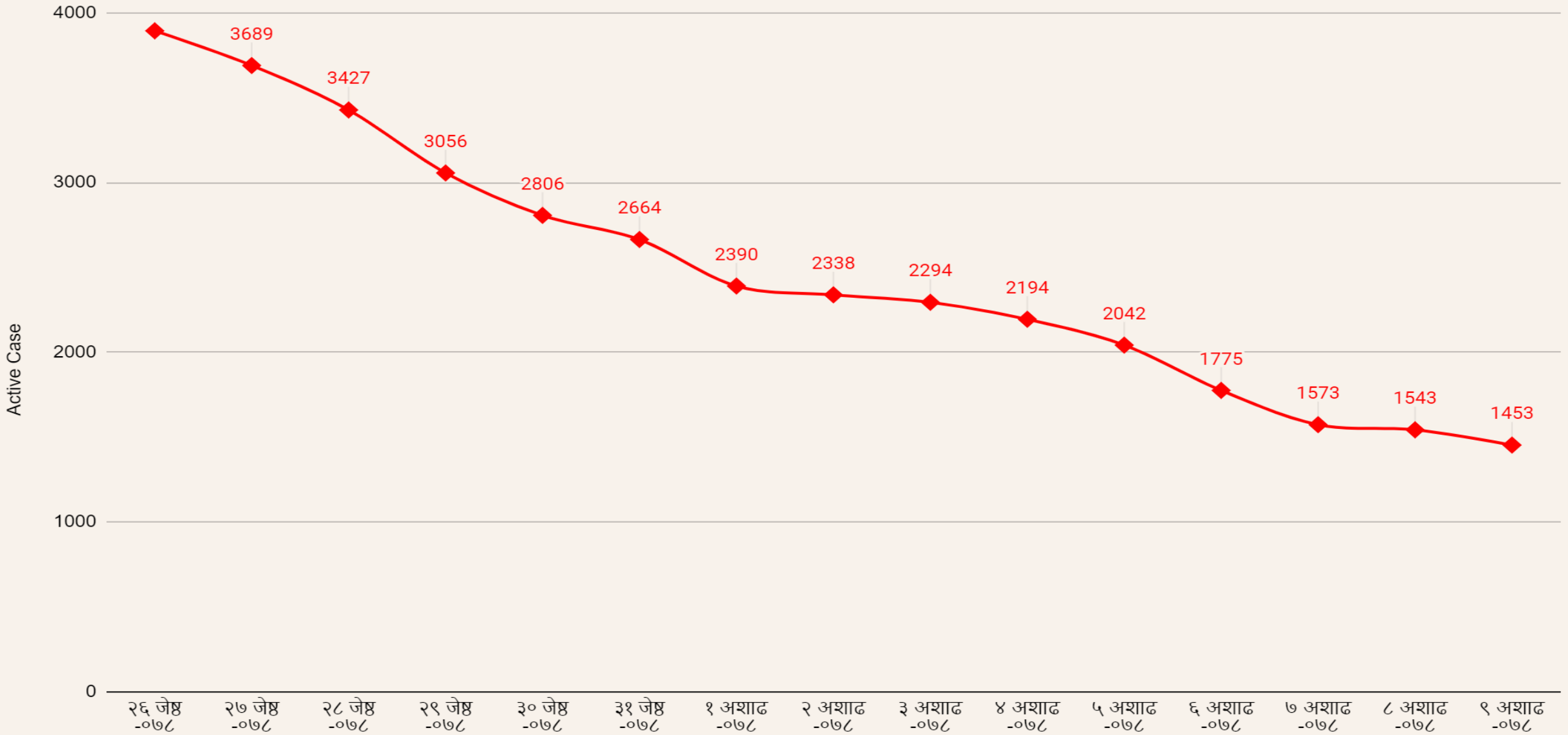

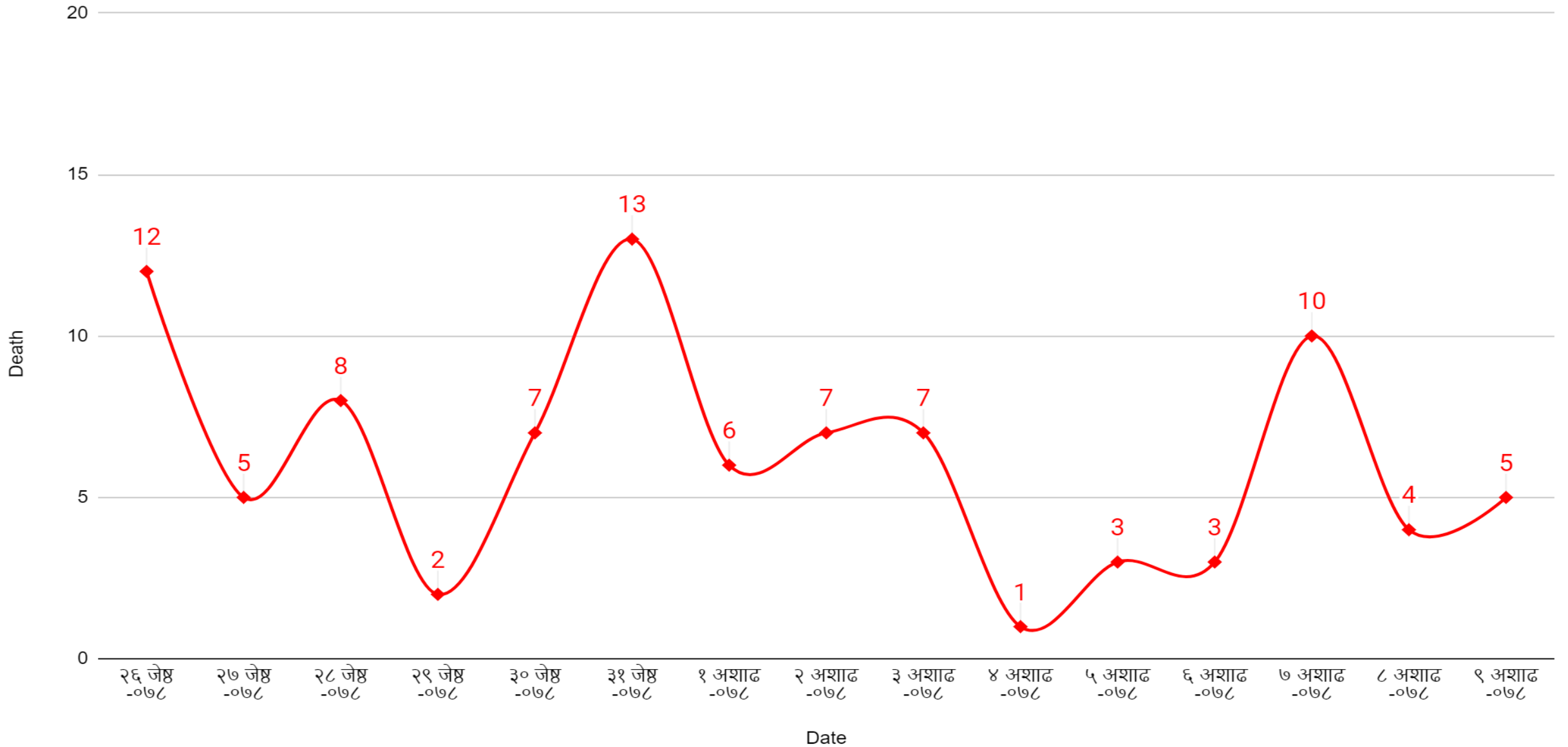
Active Case on 15 days back

Death cases on 15 days back

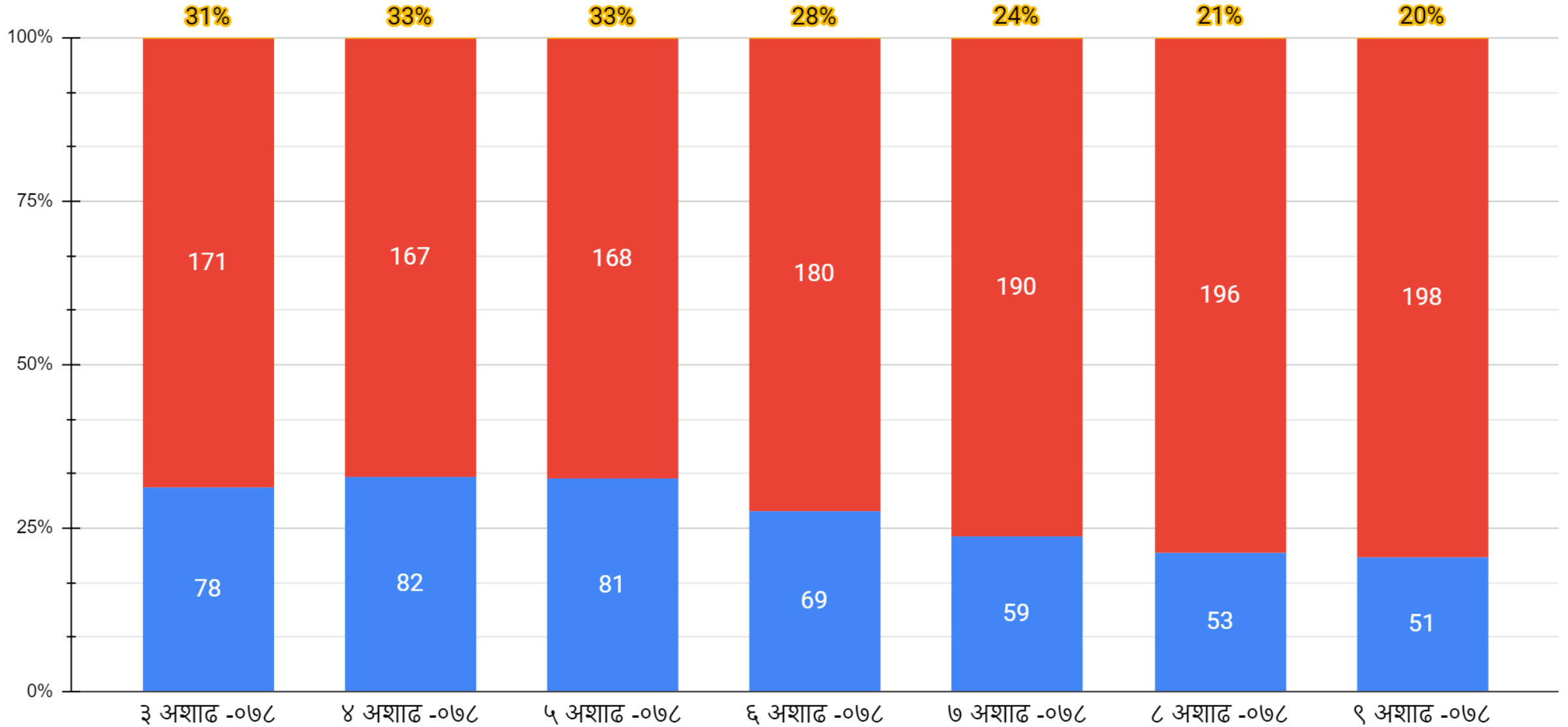

- **Monsoon Preparedness Plan**
- Since Jan 2021
 - 86 SAM cases admitted in NRH
 - 476 SAM cases admitted in OTCs

Key Highlights (including achievements of actions points)

Support from SUAAHARA II

- PSAs produced and **broadcast in 4 local languages** (Nepali, Awadhi, Tharu and Bhojpuri) on covid19 and Nutrition.
- **SMS on Covid19 & Nutrition** to households, FCHVs and health workers (N-74808 June/21).
- PPE distribution:
 - 9046 FCHV received 50 pic mask and 1 bottle sanitizer.
 - 679 Health facility received mask and sanitizer and birthing centers received PPE set.
- **Promotion in Social media boost** for talking head PSAs and animation videos.
- **Tele counselling** by field staff to 1000 days and other HH (N-14899).
 - During telephone follow up on breast feeding, food, health service, ANC, PNC, institution delivery, sick child feeding and health service, Covid19 effected mothers care.
- **OTC (42) follow up and inform orient on simplified approach on SAM/MAM treatment.**

Key Highlights (including achievements of actions points)

Support from SUAAHARA II

- Mobilize human resources (**N=5**) for screening suspect cases and counseling the returnee migrant workers at **Point of Entries of boarder** and districts
- Implement **CICT package** in (Palpa and Argakhanchi) districts. Palika level orientation ongoing.
- Monitoring and transportation support for health office and Provincial Health **Directorate for Covid19 vaccination** ongoing.
- Technical staffs regular **follow up to health facility** for update stock and regular health service status.
- Promotion of **Short videos through Facebook and YouTube** on covid19 context.
- Support and follow up to palika for planning of **nutrition program upcoming F/Y**.
- Facilitate and orient to palika and **OTC centers on Simplified approach** on SAM/MAM treatment.
- Facilitation support for conduct **CNSI- health worker and FCHV** level training to different palika of Rupandehi and Banke.

2	Real time data of under 5 COVID positive children and their status	Advocacy for the disaggregation and real time information collection of under 5 children and their nutrition status.
3	Continuity of essential nutrition services (COVID-19 Pandemic as well as upcoming monsoon season).	Finalize The Monsoon Preparedness Plan.

- Develop strategies on information collection, nutritional assessment and improve the nutrition status of under 5 children in COVID-19 context.
- **Plan to Orient on simplified approach on SAM/MAM treatment for all LLG**
